Yesterday, the IDPH announced adjustments to the mitigation metrics that were initially installed on November 20, 2020. The Pleasant Dale Park District is located within Region 10 and has now been moved out of any tiered mitigations and is in Phase 4.

When in Phase 4:

- Recreation and sporting facilities can resume additional operations with a limit of 50% capacity
- Group fitness classes of up to 50 people with at least 6-feet of social distancing permitted
- Meetings limited to the lesser of 50 people or 50% of room capacity
- Face coverings to be worn at all times, including while engaged in activities
- Competitive gameplay and tournaments permitted for moderate and lower risk sports. Intra-team scrimmage for higher risk sports (Currently our Girls Basketball League)
- Sports should follow Winter Update to All Sport Guidelines (which assigns "Level of Play" based on the specific sport and its risk level:

- Limit of 50 spectators for events (Currently limiting our Girls Basketball to 1 spectator per participant)
